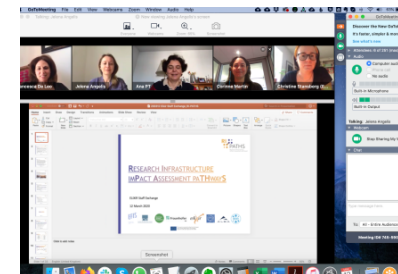
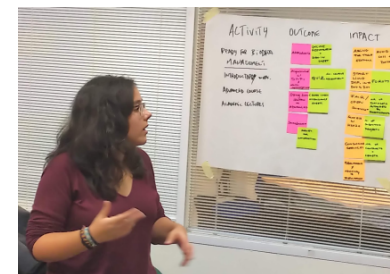
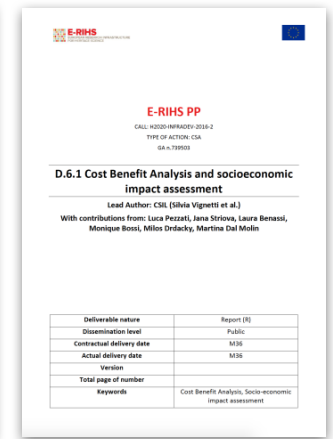
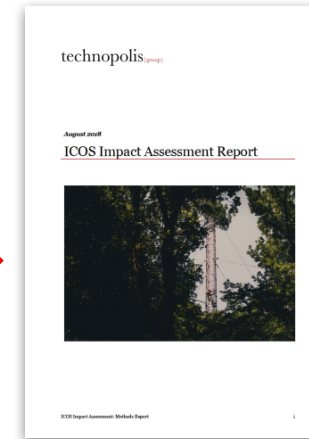
## Evidence of performance and impact:

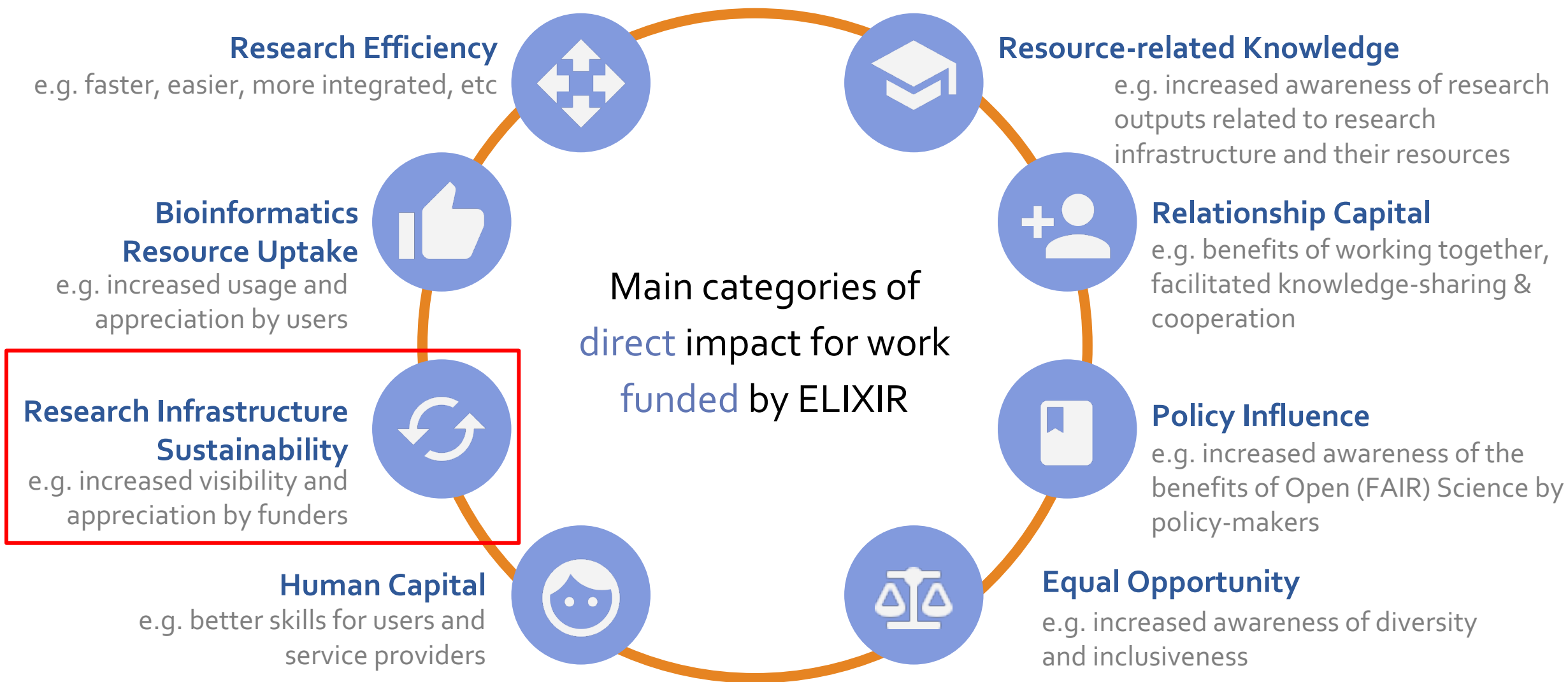

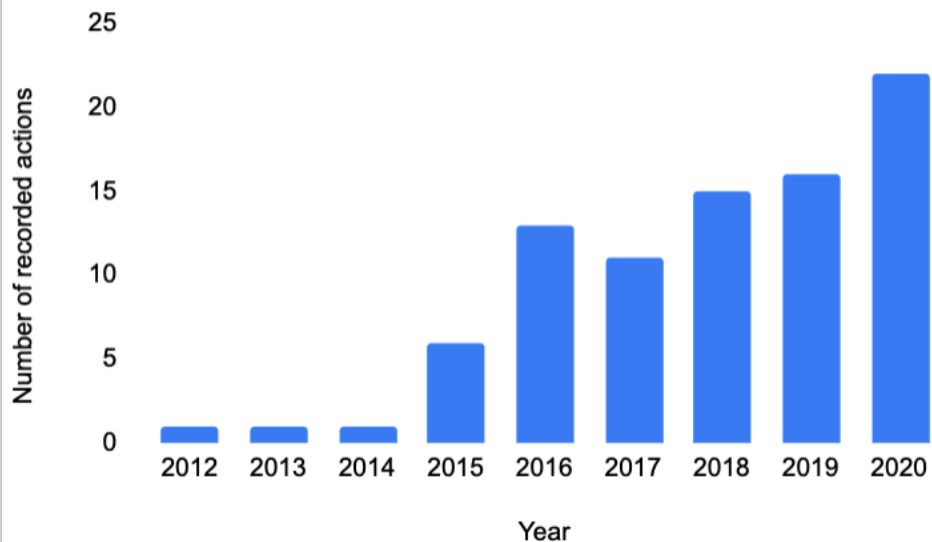

Temporal trend

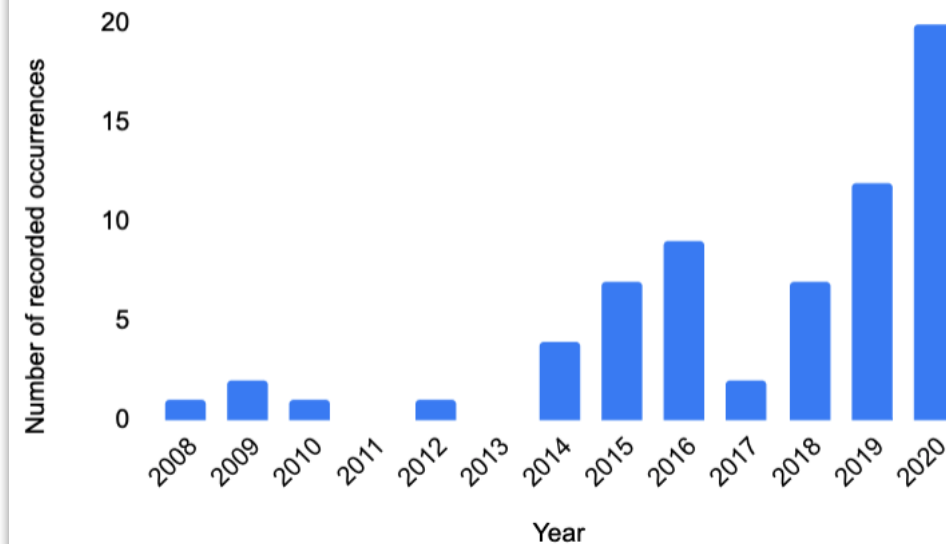

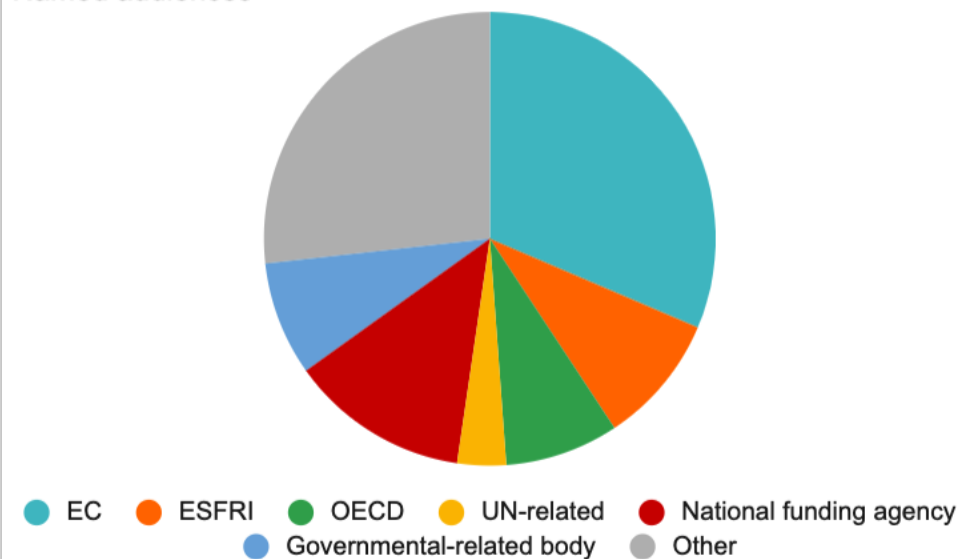
ELIXIR's visibility with funders and the policy sphere (and beyond)

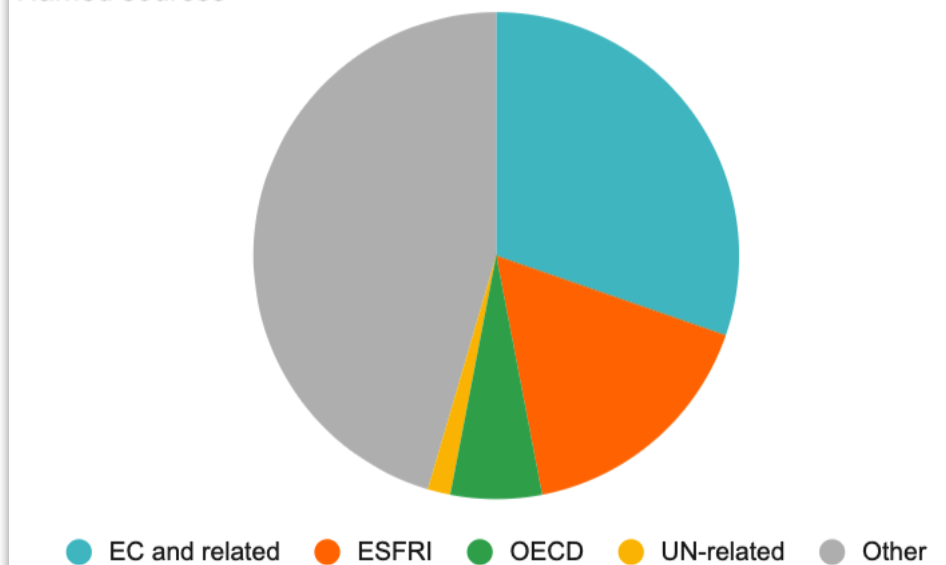
